- Bakers may enter as many different recipes as they wish as long as they provide 6 scones per recipe and a separate recipe page for each entry.
- All entries must be baked at home from scratch.
- All products should be covered and on a disposable container.
- Products that require refrigeration are unacceptable.
- No commercial mixes will be allowed.
- Bring your scones to the floral entrance at the back of the Exhibition Hall, between 9:00 and 10:00 a.m. – Saturday, August 11, 2018.
- Products must be the work of the exhibitor. All entries must be baked by an amateur baker.
- Must use King Arthur Flour with proof of purchase or KAF logo cut from flour bag; attach to entry form.
- Entries must be accompanied by the recipe typed on a recipe card or an 8 1/2" x 11" paper, listing all ingredients and procedures used; name, address, phone and e-mail of entrant.
- All recipes become the property of the Amazing Scone Baking Race. Employees or relatives of the Amazing Scone Baking Race or Title Sponsors are not eligible to enter.
- Scones will be judged on:
 - Taste (taste and aroma) 1-30 points
 - Originality, artistic flair 1-20 points
 - Ease of preparation /clarity of recipe 1-10 points
 - Overall Appearance 1-30 points
